TOO and ENOUGH

TOO

- means more than what is needed (znamená viac ako je potrebné – "príliš")

TOO + adjective (prídavné meno)

 with positive statements - zvyčajne sa používa v kladnej vete

It's **TOO HOT** to wear the coat.

Je príliš teplo obliecť si kabát.

He was driving **TOO FAST**.

On šoféroval príliš rýchlo.

ENOUGH

- means sufficient (znamená dostatočný – "dosť")

- adjective (*prídavné meno*) + **ENOUGH**

 with negative statements – zvyčajne sa používa v zápornej vete

He isn't **OLD ENOUGH** to watch that programme.

Nie je dosť starý na pozeranie toho programu.

We're not walking QUICKLY ENOUGH.

Nekráčame dosť rýchlo.
