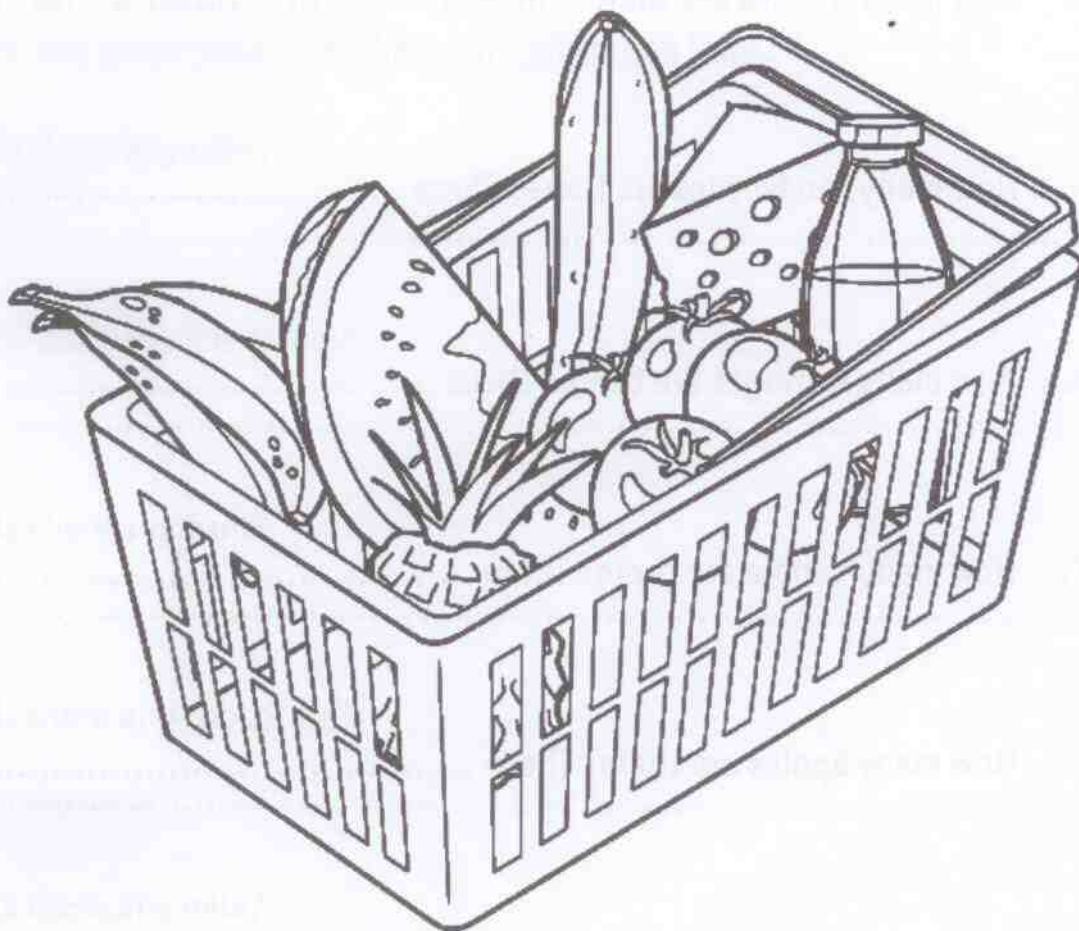
Student B
